



3.1 General Obligations (c) Implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risk	Compliant	45 CFR §164.308, §164.310, §164.312	This provision aligns with HIPAA's Security Rule requirements for administrative, physical, and technical safeguards. 3.1 General Obligations (a) Notify the Controller without undue delay after becoming aware of a personal data breach	Moderately Non- Compliant 6	45 CFR §164.410	While the clause requires notification "without undue delay," it does not specify the maximum timeframe of 60 days after discovery as required by HIPAA.	"Notify the Controller without undue delay after becoming aware of a personal data breach, and in no case later than 60 calendar days tollowing discovery of a breach."




